HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2 days: 42.5% of the new cases are female and 11.5% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections over the past 3 days were: Madinah (160), Yanbu (124), Makkah (102), Jeddah (88), Riyadh (79), Hufuf (73), Dhahran (53), and Khamis Mushait (49).
- Grand Mosque starts receiving first groups of Umrah performers after Issuing 108,041 Umrah permits in the first Week of launching the "Eaatmarna Application".
- Pilgrims will be allowed to enter in groups consisting of 1,000 pilgrims in each group and guided in separate tracks from outside the Haram to the "mataf", 16 leaders will receive them at the courtyards and direct them to the Grand Mosque.
- Recovery rate reaches 95.5% in Saudi Arabia.
