HIGHLIGHTS

• 42% of the new cases are female and 10% are children.

• Cities with highest new infections: Madinah (71), Makkah (46), Hufuf (36),Yanbu (29),Riyadh (28),Baljarshi (23),Dammam (22), Abha

(21), and Khamis Mushait (14).A robot was launched to be used in sterilization and indoor

epidemic control at the Grand Mosque in Makkah.

• Library of the Holy Mosque of Makkah sterilizes its facilities in preparation to receive 30 visitors per hour.

• General Authority of Zakat and Tax (GAZT) announced further extension of its initiative of "Cancelling fines and exemption from financial penalties for taxpayers", until the end of December.


