HIGHLIGHTS

- In 2 days: 43% of the new cases are female and 10.5% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections over the past 3 days: Madinah (189), Yanbu (123), Makkah (88), Riyadh (75), Hail (57), Hufuf (54), Khamis Mushait (42), Al Mobarraz (38) and Jeddah (26).
- The vaccination unit in King Abdullah International Medical Research Center was chosen among 10 global bodies to conduct tests aimed at standardizing biological standards for evaluating various vaccines against Covid-19.
- An automatic sterilization robot was launched to enhance preventive measures in the Prophet's Mosque.
- Ministry of Hajj: No cases of Coronavirus during the first phase of returning Umrah.
