## **HIGHLIGHTS**

- In 2 days, 41.5% of the new cases are female and 11.5% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections over the past 3 days: Madinah (178), Riyadh (118), Makkah (107), Yanbu (78), Hail (47), Hufuf (46), Al Mobarraz (43), Jeddah (34) and Dammam (33).
- MoH reiterates warning of SR1,000 fine for violating coronavirus measures.
- The Ministry of Health has advised all citizens and residents to get vaccinated with seasonal influenza vaccine.
- Saudi Arabian Airlines will resume services to 33 international destinations in November.
- WHO documents the tobacco control experience in Saudi Arabia during the Corona pandemic.
- Kuwait Airways announced resumption of its flight to Riyadh, Dammam and Jeddah airports in Saudi Arabia starting Sunday October 25, 2020.
