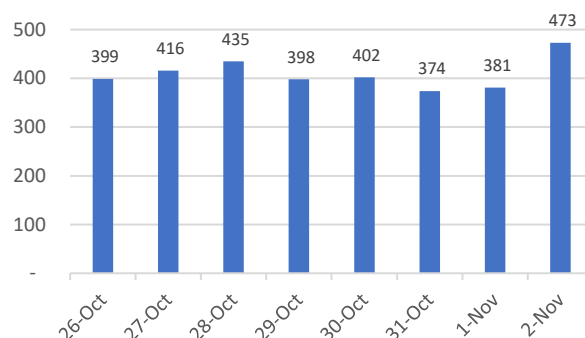

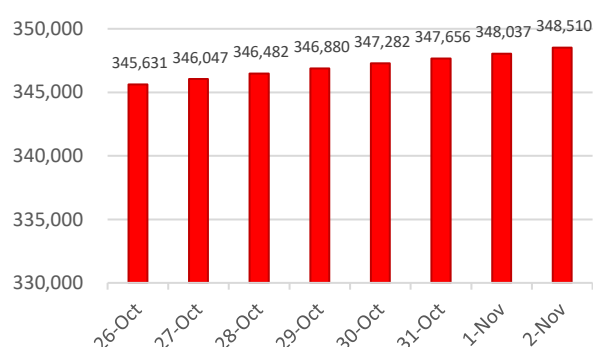
HIGHLIGHTS

- 40% of the new cases are female and 9% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections: Madinah (73), Makkah (45), Riyadh (40), Jeddah (37), Yanbu (26), Hail (18), Khamis Mushait (17) and Hufuf (13).
- Within the frame of G20 programs, the 11th Medical Research Forum discusses today the developments of Coronavirus vaccine with the representatives of the vaccine producing companies.
- The Camel Festival in Darya Governorate has been stopped for violating the preventive measures of corona virus.
- 96.2% is the recovery rate and active cases decreased to less than 8,000.

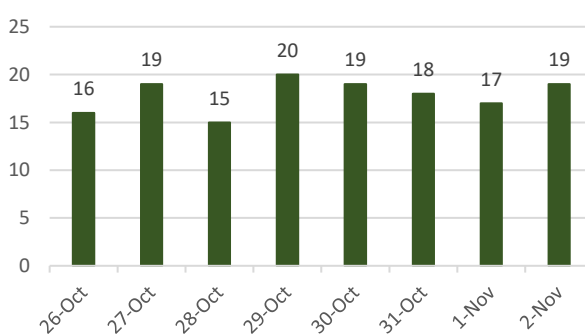
Number of New Cases
