

- 39% of the new cases are female and 10% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections: Madinah (72), Riyadh (53), Yanbu (36), Makkah (28), Hail (22), Dammam (20), Hufuf (16), and Khamis Mushait (12).
- First batch of Umrah performers coming from abroad arrives at the Grand Mosque to perform Umrah rituals after completing quarantine.




