Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Situation Report No. 18 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 1 April 2020



HIGHLIGHTS

- Out of a total of 1,720 confirmed cases, 264 recovered and were discharged, 30 are in critical condition, and 6 died (5 expatriates and 1 citizen);
- Out of the new cases 1 was travel related, and 156 were contacts of cases;
- Distribution of new cases: 78 in Madinah, 55 in Makkah, 7 in Riyadh, 6 in Qatif, remaining cases are distributed in other localities;
- Energy firms announce contributing SAR 525 million to fund COVID-19 efforts, Saudi Aramco contributed SAR 200 million out of the total;
- In a seperate announcement, Saudi Electricity Company contributed SAR 30 million, and its contracotrs and suppliers Contributed SAR 24.65 million;
- Ministry of Health attracts and qualifies 78,000 volunteers to contribute to COVID-19 control efforts if needed;
- A number of municipalities are producing sanitizers to support COVID-19 efforts;
- The government is working on an initiative to enable some expatriates to return to their countries;
- 250 Saudi physicians training in France decide to remain in France, in solidarity with their French colleagues to fight COVID-19.




