# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

## Situation Report No. 20 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 3 April 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

• Out of a total of 2,039 confirmed cases, a total of 351 recovered and were discharged, 41 are in critical condition and 4 died;

• Out of the new cases 3 were travel related, and 151 were contacts of cases;

• Distribution of new cases: 34 in Madinah, 30 in Jeddah, 21 in Makkah, 17 in Tabuk, 13 in Riyadh, 9 in Buraidah, and 6 in Qatif; the remaining cases are distributed in 12 other localities;

• The curfew in Dammam, Taif and Qatif has been extended, now it starts from 3pm and until 6 am;

• The Saudi Government decided to pay 60% of the salaries of Saudi citizens working in private sector facilities affected by the repurcutions of COVID-19 instead of terminating their contracts, this will last for 3 months, it will benefit up to 1.2 million Saudi workers and can cost the Government up to SAR 9 billion.
