Situation Report No. 26 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 9 April 2020



HIGHLIGHTS

- Total confirmed cases 3,287 on the 8th of April, 355 new cases in one day.
- Out of the total, 666 recovered and were discharged and 44 died; there are 2,577 active cases;
- Fast-track COVID-19 testing is introduced allowing drive-through sample collection from individuals while sitting in their cars.
- Distribution of newly reported cases: Madinah (89), Riyadh (83), Makkah (78), Jeddah (45), Tabuk (26), Qatif (10); in addition to cases in 12 other localities;
- Saudi Council of Engineers invites industrial companies to manufacture ventilators as a contribution to the efforts of combating COVID-19.
- The deadline for receiving requests from citizens wishing to return to Saudi Arabia has been extended until April 14.
- Saudi Arabia to contribute additional SAR 25 million to WHO to combat COVID-19.




