Situation Report No. 27 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 10 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• Total confirmed cases 3,651 as of the 9th of April, 364 new cases.

• Out of the total, 685 recovered and were discharged and 3 new virus-related deaths; there are 2,919 active cases;

• Distribution of newly reported cases: Makkah (90), Madinah (78), Riyadh (69), Jeddah (54), Tabuk (22), Qatif (12); in addition to cases in 14 other localities;

• The first evacuation flight transporting 250 Saudi citizens back to the Kingdom arrived on Friday morning from Indonesia;

• Saudi Arabia's interior ministry announces lockdown in 6 neighbourhoods of Madinah and a partial curfew in the seventh till further notice, to prevent the spread of coronavirus effective from Friday. Meanwhile, authorities will provide food baskets, medicines and other supplies to needy families in those neighbourhoods.




