Situation Report No. 28 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 11 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• Total confirmed cases 4,033 on the 11th of April, 382 new cases in one day.

• Out of the total, 720 recovered and were discharged and 5 new mortalities were recorded; there are 3,261 active cases, and 67 receiving intensive care.

• Distribution of newly reported cases: Makkah (131), Madinah (95), Riyadh (76), Jeddah (50), Dammam (15); in addition to cases in 7 other localities;

• Treatment using plasma from recovered patients is under study in Saudi Arabia.

• 3 flights have arrived and other trips by land with a total number of arrivals being more than 1,630 Saudi citizens returning back.




