Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

Situation Report No. 30 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 13 April 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- Out of the total, 805 recovered and were discharged and 6 new mortalities were recorded; there are 4,064 active cases, 59 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of newly reported cases: Riyadh (118), Madinah (113), Makkah (95), Jeddah (80), and Tabuk (22); in addition to cases in 12 other localities;
- Citizens continue arriving as part of the repatriation programme.
- Al-Bahah has started using thermal drones to monitor people's temperatures in open spaces and markets to combat COVID-19.
- People were urged to use government-authorized applications for deliveries, by MoH, and recommends using electronic payment methods to avoid handling cash.
- Ministry of Interior introduces new movement permits, standardizing the process to control the number of persons on the streets, violators to be fined SAR10,000.
- Minister of health announced in his speech yesterday that number of cases has doubled in a week with rapid rise in labour camps and crowded neighbourhoods.




