# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

## Situation Report No. 32 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 15 April 2020

# **HIGHLIGHTS**

- Out of a total of 5,862 cases, 931 recovered and were discharged and 6 new mortalities were recorded; there are 4,852 active cases, 71 of them in critical care.
- Distribution of newly reported cases: Madinah (109), Hufof (86), Dammam (84), Jeddah (69), Riyadh (56), Makkah (40); in addition to cases in 14 other localities;
- MoH: most COVID-19 cases, in recent days, are detected in the overcrowded districts or workers' dormitories.
- Ministry of Education to hand over 3,445 educational buildings to municipalities to accomodate workers to reduce crowding in workers' dormitories.
- Repatriation of Umra visitors to their countries is continuing.
- Eight factories in Saudi Arabia produce 3.7 million face masks weekly.
- Al-Atheer district in Dammam city is isolated with movement in and out banned.
- Maaden donates SR 15 Million to Health Ministry for Combating COVID-19 Spread.
- WHO updates its COVID-19 strategy on the 14th of April, see link below.
- On 7-8 April, WHO held a global, online consultation on managing the COVID-19 infodemic (An infodemic is an over-abundance of information, some accurate and some not that makes it hard for people to find trustworthy sources and reliable guidance). For conference material see link below.




