# Situation Report No. 48 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 03 May 2020

# HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,552 new cases in one day, bringing total to 27,011. Of the new cases, 19 % were Saudis, and 16% were females.
- 369 new recoveries, bringing total to 4,134.
- 8 new mortalities bringing total to 184. Mortalities were 2 Saudis in Dammam and Jeddah; 6 non-Saudis in Makkah, Riyadh, Madinah and Jeddah with age range 32-84.
- There are 22,693 active cases, 139 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Jeddah (245), Makkah (221), Jubail (156), Dammam (150) Madinah (139), and Baish (111); in addition to cases in 25 other localities.
- MoH spokesperson: 80,000 beds are the general capacity of all sectors providing services, including 8000 ICU beds.
- In collaboration with WHO, seven hospitals participate in four trials for COVID19 treatment. Preliminary results are expected within weeks. In addition, other researchers are studying the therapeutic effects of using plasma from recovered patients.
- Riyadh inaugurates the "Khairat" Blessings platform which receives requests for assistance from COVID-19 affected families.
- Ministry of Municipalities encourages reporting of workers housing violations on the 940 hotline.


