HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,645 new cases in one day, bringing total to 28,656. Of the new cases, 19 % were Saudis, and 13% were females.
- 342 new recoveries, bringing total to 4,476.
- 7 new mortalities bringing total to 191. Mortalities were non-Saudis in Makkah and Jeddah with age range 39-87. most of them had chronic diseases.
- There are 23,989 active cases, 143 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Makkah (287), Dammam (261), Jeddah (261), Jubail (217), Madinah (152), Hofuf (133) and Riyadh (131); in addition to cases in 35 other localities.
- MOH completes 55,000 visits to health facilities to provide awareness and ensure application of preventive measures, 1,000 violations detected.

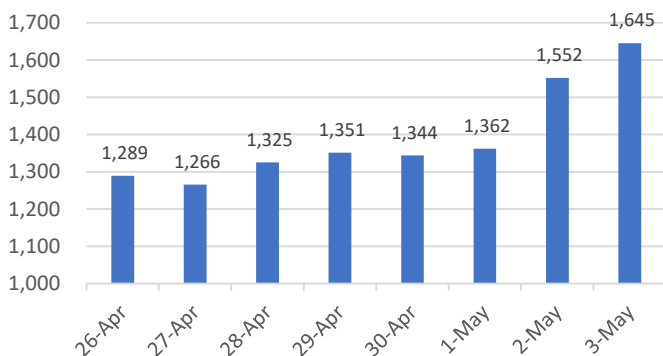

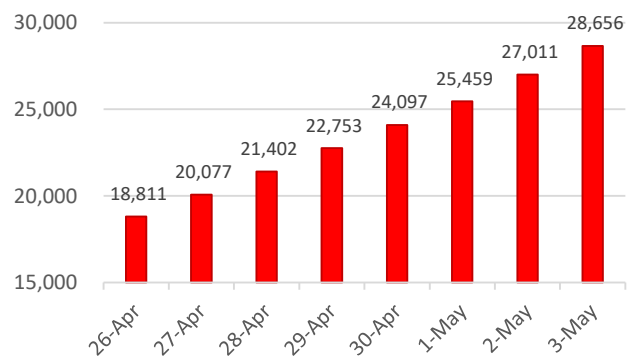
