HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,595 new cases in one day, bringing total to 30,251. Of the new cases, 24% were Saudis, and 14% were females.
- 955 new recoveries, bringing total to 5,431.
- 9 new mortalities bringing total to 200. Mortalities were 1 Saudi woman in Riyadh (34 years old) and 8 non-Saudis in Makkah, Madinah, Jaddah and Buraidah with age range 34-75.
- There are 24,620 active cases, 143 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Jeddah (385), Makkah (337), Riyadh (230), Dammam (141), Jubail (120), and Hofuf (101); in addition to cases in 21 other localities.
- Saudi Arabia announced new stricter fines and penalties of up to SAR 1 million, and up to five years in prison for violating coronavirus measures; including expulsion and no-entry for life for expatriates. The heaviest penalties are for deliberate spread of COVID-19.
- A joint initiative between "MODON" and MOH to implement precautionary measures and active screening among workers in the 2nd Industrial city in Riyadh.




