# Coronavirus disease 2019 (COVID-19)

## Situation Report No. 51 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 06 May 2020

### HIGHLIGHTS

• 1,687 new cases in one day, bringing total to 31,938. Of the new cases, 27 % were Saudis, and 20% were females, and 6% were children.

• 1,352 new recoveries, bringing total to 6,783.

• 9 new mortalities bringing total to 209. Mortalities were 1 Saudi woman in Jeddah (69 years old) and 8 non-Saudis in Makkah, Riyadh ,Madinah, and Jaddah with age range 27-82.

• There are 24,946 active cases, 137 of them in critical condition.

• Distribution of new cases: Jeddah (312), Makkah (308), Madinah (292), Taif (163), Riyadh (149), Jubail (93); in addition to cases in 37 other localities.

• MoH: the online coronavirus self-test allows individuals to check the severity of their symptoms and connect them with medical experts. Around one million people self-evaluated themselves.


