Situation Report No. 52 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 09 May 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

• 5,198 new cases were recorded over the past 3 days (see graph below), bringing total cases to 37,136. Of the new cases, 26% were Saudis, 16% were females and 5% were children.

• 3,361 new recoveries, bringing total to 10,144.

• 30 new mortalities bringing total to 239. Mortalities were 2 Saudis (in Madinah and Jeddah) and 28 non-Saudis residing mainly in Makkah, Riyadh, Al-Madinah and Jeddah; age range 30-78, many had chronic diseases.

• There are 26,856 active cases, 140 of them in critical condition.

• Lifting Precautionary Measures in Number of Madinah's Districts Starting 9th of May.

• Extended check-up and testing campaign: started with the guided proactive mapping, the second phase will proceed with those who have undergone self-assessment through laboratory testing application.




