Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 10 May 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,912 new cases in one day, bringing total to 39,048. Of the new cases, 35% are Saudis, 21% are females, and 8% children.
- 1,313 new recoveries, bringing total to 11,457.
- 7 new mortalities bringing total to 246. Mortalities were all non-Saudis (4 in Jeddah, 2 in Riyadh and 1 in Madinah).
- There are 27,345 active cases, 143 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Makkah (438), Jeddah (374), Riyadh (363), Madinah (248), Dammam (104), Hofuf (72); in addition to cases in 38 other localities.
- Economic consequences to COVID-19: the government will raise value added tax from 5% to 15% starting July 1st and suspend giving out cost of living allowance starting June 1st, and reduce government spending by SAR 100 billion.
- Authorities will lift the 24-hour curfew previously imposed on Samtah governorate in Jazan region starting from Monday.




