HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,966 new cases in one day, bringing total to 41,014. Of the new cases, 38% are Saudis, 22% are females, and 7% children.
- 1,280 new recoveries, bringing total to 12,737.
- 9 new mortalities bringing total to 255. Mortalities were 2 Saudis women, 1 in Jeddah (86 years old) and 1 in Makkah (34 years old) and 7 non-Saudis residing mainly in Makkah, Madinah, Jeddah and Taif; age range 27-86.
- There are 28,022 active cases, 149 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Riyadh (520), Makkah (343), Madinah (257), Jeddah (236), Hofuf (137), Dammam (95); in addition to cases in 36 other localities.
- Ministry of Defence builds 2 mobile hospitals to support health efforts in Makkah.
- Tabuk Region: 18 field committees formed to visit workers residences.
- The Medical City of King Saud University participates in the Unity Study of the WHO.
- WHO has published new guidance on Surveillance strategies for COVID-19 infection (see link below).




