## Situation Report No. 55 - Kingdom of Saudi Arabia

Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 12 May 2020

### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 1,911 new cases in one day, bringing total to 42,925. Of the new cases, 31% are Saudis, 18% are females, and 6% children.
- 2,520 new recoveries, bringing total to 15,257.
- 9 new mortalities bringing total to 264. Mortalities were 2 Saudis in Jeddah, 1 woman (53 years) and 1 man (64 years) and 7 non-Saudis in Makkah, Jeddah and Wadi Al-Dawasir: age range 29-64.
- There are 27,404 active cases, 147 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Riyadh (443), Makkah (407), Jeddah (306), Madinah (176), Hofuf (91), Dammam (78); in addition to cases in 38 other localities.
- Complete curfew in Baish of Jazan Region for 24 Hours Effective 12 May.
- Relaxation of curfew until the end of Ramadan, followed by complete curfew during the period from 30 Ramadan until 4 Shawwal.
- Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers. (see link below).




