Data as reported by national authorities by 23:59 local time 13 May 2020

HIGHLIGHTS

- 1,905 new cases in one day, bringing total to 44,830. Of the new cases, 32% are Saudis, 22% are females, and 8% children.
- 2,365 new recoveries, bringing total to 17,622.
- 9 new mortalities bringing total to 273. Mortalities were 2 Saudis in Makkah, 1 man (80 years) and 1 woman (48 years) and 7 non-Saudis in Makkah and Jeddah: age range 42-80.
- There are 26,935 active cases, 147 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Riyadh (673), Jeddah (338), Makkah (283), Dammam (147), Hofuf (67), Madinah (64); in addition to cases in 43 other localities.
- The Central Board for Accreditation of Healthcare updates hospital standards to better combat coronavirus spread.
- Ministry of Defense has deployed a fleet of medical evacuation aircraft to transport emergency and critical cases within the Kingdom.
- Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers. (see link below).




