HIGHLIGHTS

- 2,736 new cases in one day, bringing total to 54,752. Of the new cases, 40% are Saudis, 22% are females, and 9% children.
- 2,056 new recoveries, bringing total to 25,722.
- 10 new mortalities bringing total to 312. Mortalities were non-Saudis in Jeddah, Al-Kharj, Makkah, Riyadh, Nairyah, and Madinah; age range 26 - 60.
- There are 28,718 active cases, 202 of them in critical condition.
- Distribution of new cases: Makkah (557), Riyadh (488), Madinah (392), Jeddah (375), Dammam (286), Hofuf (149); in addition to cases in 51 other localities.
- Saudi Arabia intensifies its testing capabilities to provide between 15,000 and 18,000 tests a day.
- 91 Indonesian nationals returned to Jakarta from Riyadh under Awdah (Return) Initiative.
- Of the 3,334 curfew violations, 1,845 violators were in Riyadh, 281 in Makkah and 277 in Eastern Province.
- MoH is planning to double testing to conduct up to 36,000 COVID-19 tests daily.
- WHO: Smokers are more likely to develop severe disease with COVID-19, compared to non-smokers; WHO has published new guidance on "Cleaning and disinfection of environmental surfaces in the context of COVID-19"; WHO provided guidance on school related public health measures (see link below).




