#### **HIGHLIGHTS**

- 1,869 new cases bringing total cases to 89,011. Of the new cases, 44% were Saudis.
- 1,484 new recoveries, bringing total to 65,790.
- 24 new mortalities bringing total to 549.
- There are 22,672 active cases, 1,264 of them in critical condition.
- 15,364 PCR tests were conducted, reaching a total of 853,987.
- Ministry of Interior announces new mitigation measures affecting several sectors including mining, industrial and transport sectors (see link for detailed measures).
- 3 flights evacuate 530 Pakistanis and 16 corpses, bringing total evacuated by the government of Pakistan from the Kingdom to 1,434.
- Roughly 30% increase in divorces in Saudi Arabia during the COVID-19 crisis.
- After their car overturns while volunteering to deliver medicines as part of COVID-19 effort, two medical students receive 2 new cars as a gift from the Emir of Asir.
- WHO released two new documents: key planning recommendations for mass gatherings in the context of COVID-19; and, technical guidance for the prevention and control of COVID-19 across long-term care services (see links below).
- WHO lists all candidate COVID-19 vaccines in various stages of development without endorsing any of them (see link below).




