

#### HIGHLIGHTS

- 37% of the new cases are females and 63% male.
- Cities with highest new infections: Hufuf (343), Dammam (286), Taif (284), Makkah (278), Qatif (237), Riyadh (225) and Jeddah (214).
- Ministry of Islamic Affairs announce the resumption of lessons and lectures in mosques.
- WHO supports Saudi Arabia's decision on Hajj with limited number of pilgrims this year.
- The space allocated for each pilgrim for this year's Hajj will be four times larger than the area allocated previously.
- A research study is going on with the participation of 18 hospitals about the effective use of convalescent plasma to treat coronavirus infected persons.
- WHO updates criteria for releasing patients from isolation (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages.
