





HIGHLIGHTS

- 37% of the new cases are female and 9% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections were: Riyadh (288), Jeddah (243), Taif (187), Hufuf (171), Makkah (142), Khamis Mushait (141), Dammam (133), Al Mobarraz (122), and Madinah (117).
- In Taif: launching 4 new Tettaman clinics and a drive through testing centre.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
- WHO releases "WHO Academy" mobile application providing COVID-19 resources for health workers in 6 UN languages, see link below.
