HIGHLIGHTS

- 35% of the new cases are female and 10% are children.
- Cities with highest new infections are: Riyadh (258), Jeddah (235), Hufuf (203), Dammam (177), Al Mobarraz (170), Taif (131), Abha (123), Najran (115) and Makkah (82).
- Ministry of Hajj & Umrah announced that a prayer rug, sanitizers and masks will be supplied to each pilgrim; also, a smart card, with all details regarding the operation and management of pilgrimage, will be provided.
- Penalty will be doubled with the repetition of COVID-19 violations.
- King Fahd causeway will tentatively open after Eid Al-Adha.
- Solidarity trial interim results show that

hydroxychloroquine and lopinavir/ritonavir produce little or no reduction in mortality of hospitalized COVID-19 patients (see link below).
